#### **Professional Bio**

Marketa Marvanova, PharmD, PhD, BCGP, BCPP, FASCP, serves as Professor and Dean of Pacific University School of Pharmacy in Hillsboro, Oregon. She is Board-Certified Psychiatric and Geriatric Pharmacist and Fellow of the ASCP, her clinical expertise is geriatrics and neuropsychiatry and she has practiced in a variety of inpatient and outpatient team-based clinical settings. Since 2013, she has served on the editorial board for *Continuum: Life-long Learning in Neurology* (American Academy of Neurology). As a clinician, educator, scholar, and servant, she focuses her passion and efforts to the enhancing training in geriatrics and neuropsychiatry and improving health outcomes for older adults. She published 13 peer reviewed articles specifically in older adult care. Since 2012, she has provided 42 hours of continuing education (CE) and/or BCGP-recertification sessions to ASCP membership and another 25 CEs in other geriatrics venues. She is also a frequent speaker and supporter of Parkinson's disease support groups, consultant on geriatric and neurologic complex cases, and served on a variety of ASCP committees. She developed and executed two large grant-funded state-level outreach projects: Targeted Education in Dementia Care for Pharmacists, and Pharmacist-led Community-Based Education, Screening and Service Initiative in ND, and is co-investigator on an ongoing multi-phase study on older adult health disparities (2012-present).
